

Notice at the start of the service

As you know East Devon has now been moved into Tier 3. Unfortunately the rules are now tighter but please with bear with us. Their only purpose is to minimise the chance of you catching COVID-19 or unknowingly passing it on to someone else.

- We ask you to hand sanitise when you arrive.
- To maintain social distancing, please sit where the welcomers ask you to go.
- We should not be having conversations with anyone in church beyond what is essential for the service.
- The areas at the front of the church are more than 2 metres away from others, so people contributing from there may remove masks while speaking.
- We should otherwise keep our masks on and not get within 1 metre of anyone outside our household or bubble.
- We'll play you the hymns. We're not allowed to sing them but we do encourage humming!

Notice before Holy Communion

- We have a one way system for receiving communion
- Please wait until the welcomer indicates to you
- Then come up the centre aisle
- Stretch your hand forward for the bread
- Please take it forward with you to the right, past the Bindon Chapel, down the side aisle
- and eat it when you get back to your seat

Notice at the end of the service

- Please stay in your seat until a welcomer indicates to you.
- Then make straight for the exit door, stopping only if you wish to place an offering in the wall safe to the left of the door.
- I'm sorry we still can't allow conversation while you're in the building.
- Also under Tier 3 we should not form meeting groups outside in the churchyard either.
