The **Banner Men**, bearing the Royal Oak Banner will lead us from the **Chestnut Tree** down to the **Village Churchyard** to watch the ceremony of the raising of the **Royal Oak Bough** to the top of the Church Tower.

The **King** will then proclaim the **Restoration of the Monarchy** and announce a **Public Holiday**.

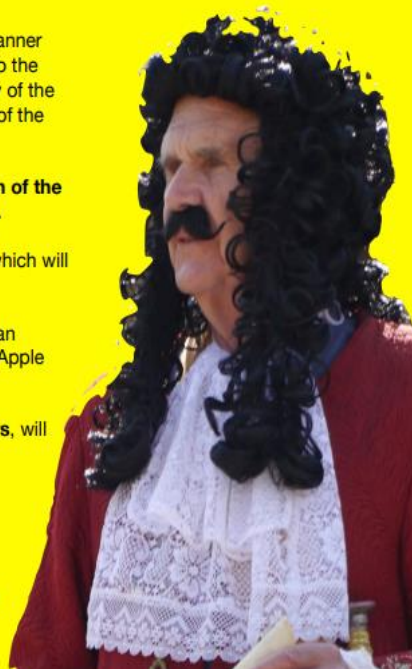
He will then preside over the **Great Feast** which will take place in the **Village Hall** at **6.45 p.m.**
