The Banner Men, bearing the Royal Oak Banner will lead us from the Chestnut Tree down to the Village Churchyard to watch the ceremony of the raising of the Royal Oak Bough to the top of the Church Tower.

The King will then proclaim the Restoration of the Monarchy and announce a Public Holiday.

He will then preside over the Great Feast which will take place in the Village Hall at 6.45 p.m.


